THE FUTURE IN THE COLD STORAGE MARKET

According to a new study conducted by Grand View Research, the global cold storage market size is expected to reach \$485 billion by 2030, with an annual increase of approximately 17.2%. The growth of the retail sector in emerging economies such as India and China causes the demand for cold storage to increase rapidly. Other highlights of the cold storage market report are as follows;

- Developments in low carbon design, environmental control and energy saving technologies are expected to increase the demand for cold storage.
- The evolving supermarket shopping culture and increasing consumer preference for private label are key factors for the expansion of food retail chains worldwide.
- Frozen product segment is expected to increase by 16.2% and processed food segment by 20.6% year-on-year. Growth is attributed to significant changes in consumers' living standards and food consumption behavior.



NASA CREW-5, MAKING FOOD PRODUCTION IN SPACE, RETURNED TO EARTH

Crew-5, conducted by NASA with SpaceX, completed its research on the International Space Station and returned to Earth. "This international team has performed critical science experiments that will help us prepare for future deep space missions and pave the way for our return to the Moon," said NASA Administrator Bill Nelson. During their time at the station, the astronauts tested hydroponic and aeroponic techniques to grow plants without using soil, and also conducted a range of medical research, including the production of essential nutrients from yeast-based beverages such as yogurt and kefir.



RUNTALYA 2023

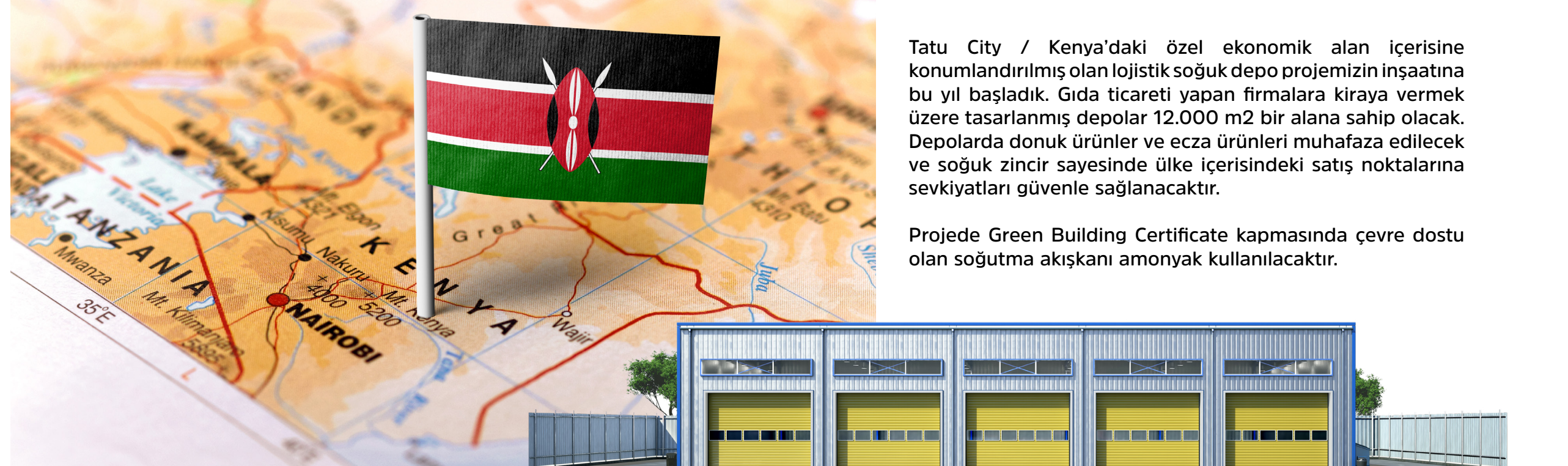

OUR NEW COLD STORAGE PROJECT IN KENYA

SIGNIFICANT VISIT FROM ZIMBABWE

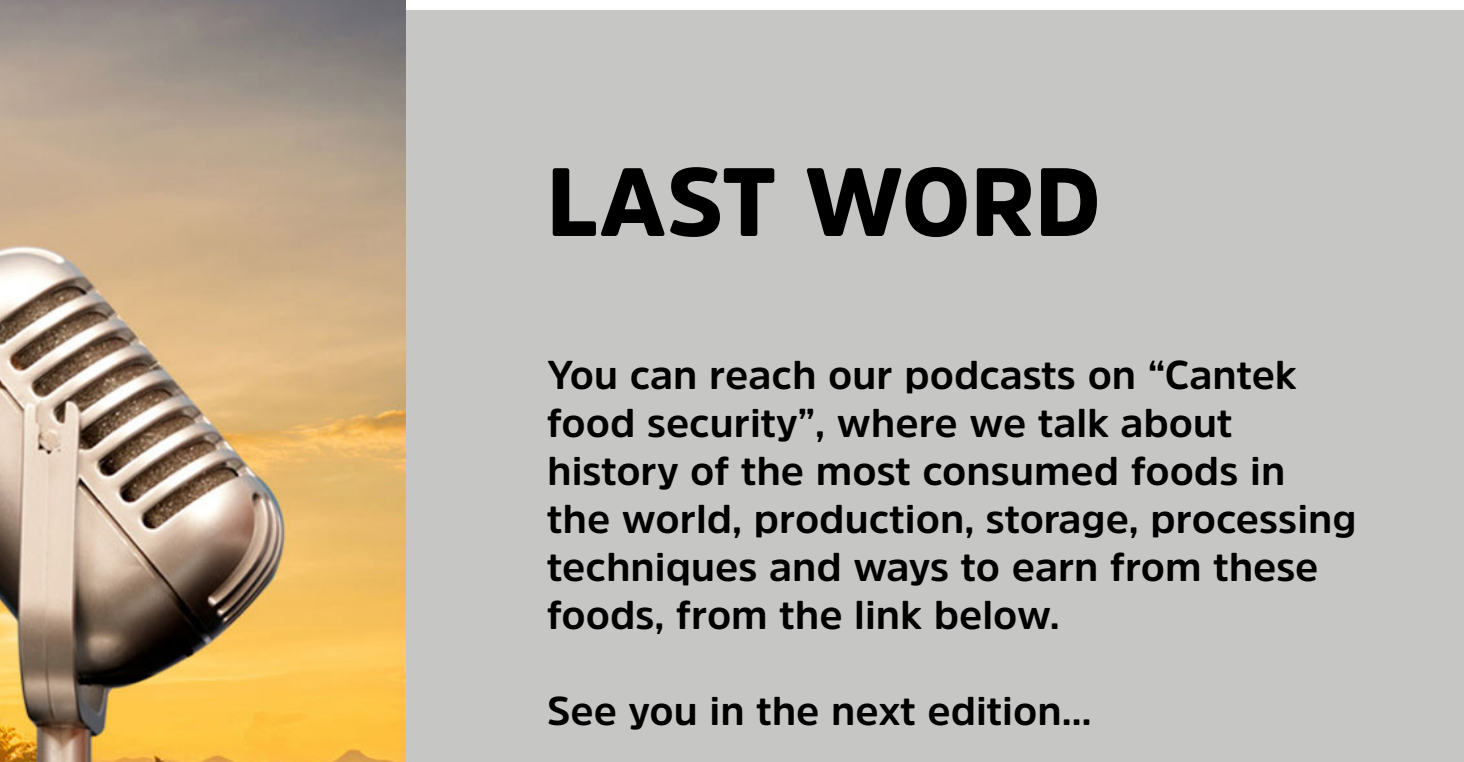
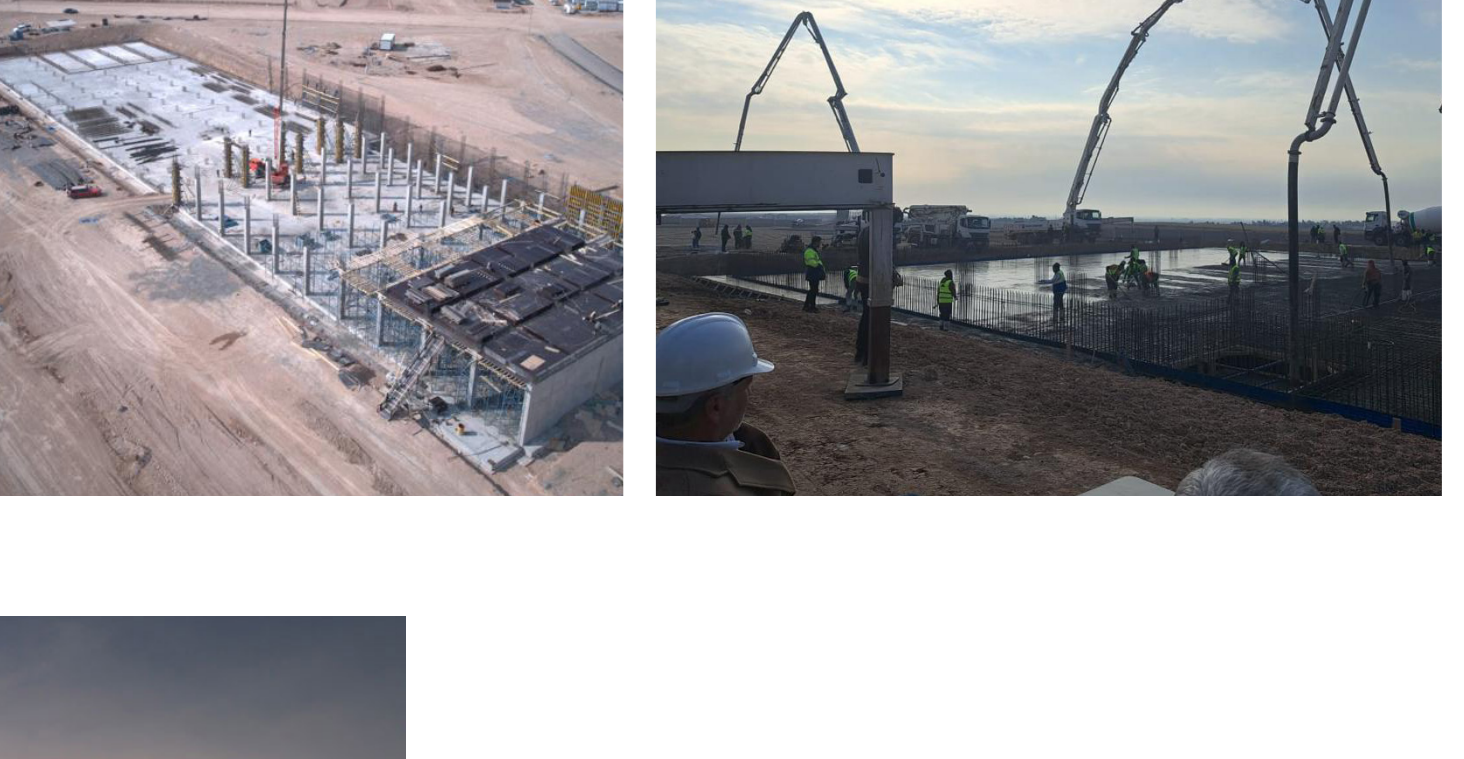

OUR NEW SLAUGHTERHOUSE PROJECT IN IRAQ

We are carrying out a large slaughterhouse project in the livestock shelter and sales area complex, which will be established on an area of 1 million m2 in Erbil / Iraq. The slaughterhouse, which we started to work on as of 2023, will have a daily slaughter capacity of 350 cattle and 3,000 sheep and goats. In addition to the slaughterhouse, there will also be advanced meat processing, offal processing and cold stores. This project, which will contribute greatly to the agriculture and livestock economy of the region, will have a closed area of 18,500m2.
